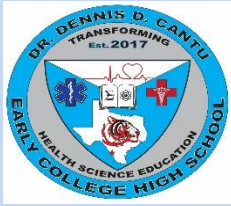

- I understand satisfactory progress, demonstrated self-discipline, and regular attendance are mandatory for continued study at the Early College High School.
- I agree to attend and support school functions including but not limited to: Open House, Parent Meetings, Conference, Parent Information Sessions and access Parent Portal via Skyward.
- I will encourage and expect high academic and behavior standards from my child.
- I will exhibit and encourage my child to exhibit the following character traits: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Citizenship.
- I understand that the early college high school might not operate on a calendar similar to Laredo Community College.
- I understand my child is required to be in attendance when LISD is in session as well as when LCC is in session. Due to the rigorous nature of the coursework, exemplary attendance is expected and required. Students who have more than 3 unexcused absences as well as excessive late arrivals are subject to removal from the program.
- I understand that my child will be required to devote a minimum of 2 hours each evening to homework and that he/she will be expected to attend the Laredo Community College tutorial center for additional assistance.
- I understand my child will be taking college level courses and these courses will be taught at the college level and will require reading college level materials not typically read in High School.
- I understand that my child will be afforded an opportunity to earn up to 60 college hours. He/She is expected to maintain a grade point average of 2.5 and follow the university grading guidelines. Failure to meet Cantu ECHS and LCC grading requirements may result in removal from the program.
- I understand that LCC's Grade "D" is passing for LCC but a "C" must be earned to receive high school credit.
- I understand that my child must comply with all Laredo I.S.D. and Laredo Community College regulations at all times. Violations may result in removal from the program.
- I understand that my child will be expected to attend Summer Bridge Programs.
- I understand my child will be enrolled full time as a Martin High School Student.
